Gilbert C WELLISCH became a doctor and served in WW1 mainly in England, and some time in France. At the war's end he obtained his discharge papers in England and remained there.

Edward M WELLISCH became a professor of mathematics at Sydney University. He and Margaret had a son that died in infancy in 1930. They had no other children. In 1938 Edward sponsored family members to Australia – they were fleeing the Nazi regime in Austria.
